

2 to 4 Players Ages 4 & Up



Object:

Be first to play all your cards.

Set Up:

Shuffle and deal six cards, face-down, to everyone. Place the rest of the cards in the center to form the draw pile. Turn over the top card and place it next to the draw pile to start the discard pile.

Play:

- Gather up your cards and hold them in your hand so you can see them.
- If you're left of the dealer, you play first.
- You may play (discard) any card that matches either the color or the number of the top card on the discard pile.
- If you don't have any cards you can play, you must draw from the draw pile until you get one that is playable.

• Eights are "crazy," which means they're wild. You can play any Eight on any card, regardless of color or number. If you play an Eight, you get to name the color that the next person must play.



 Play continues until somebody plays his or her last card, or until nobody can play any of their cards.

Winning:

If you are the first player to get rid of all your cards, you're the winner! If nobody was able to get rid of all their cards, the player with the lowest number of cards at the end of the game is the winner.
